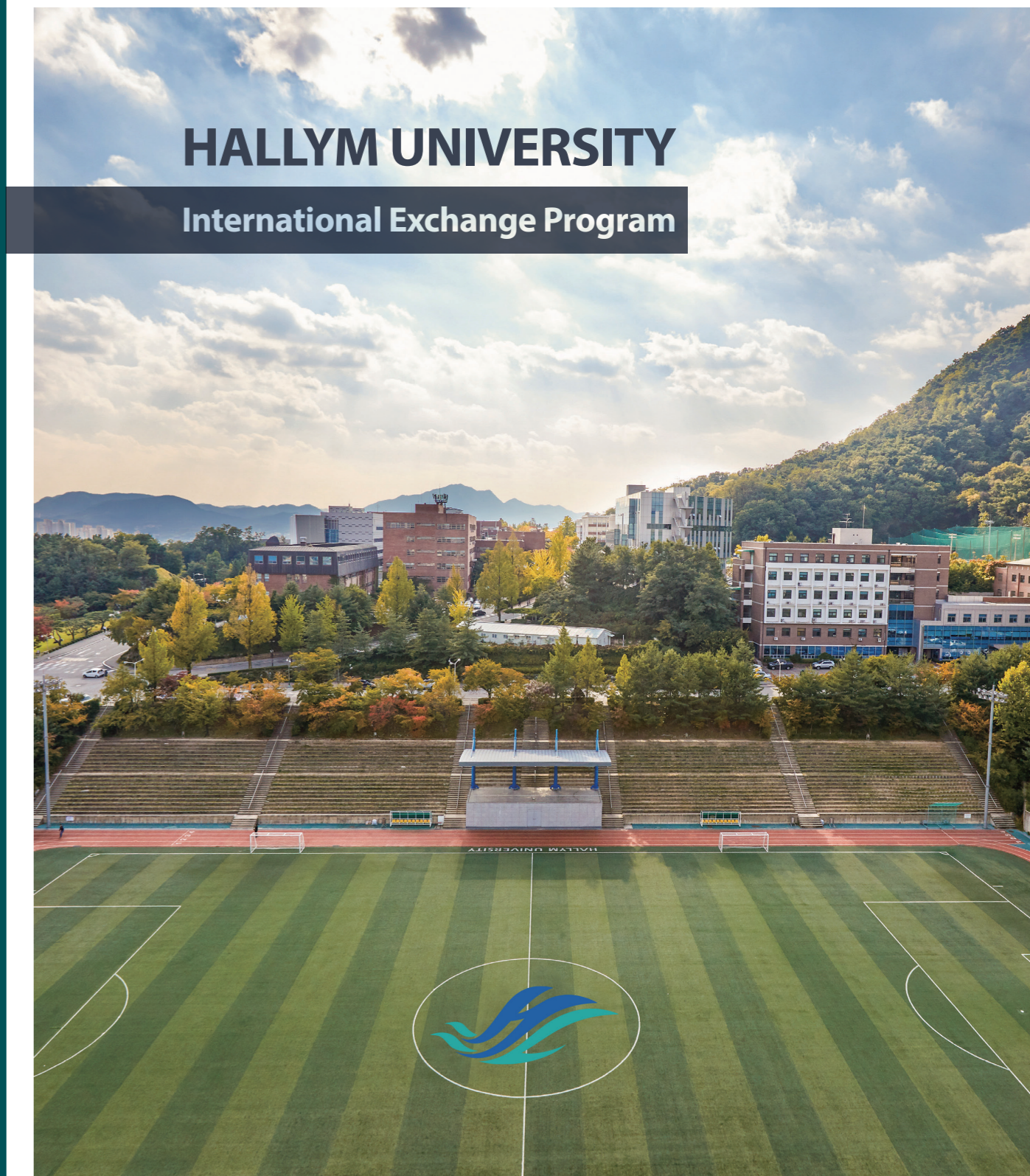

A Unique Cultural Experience

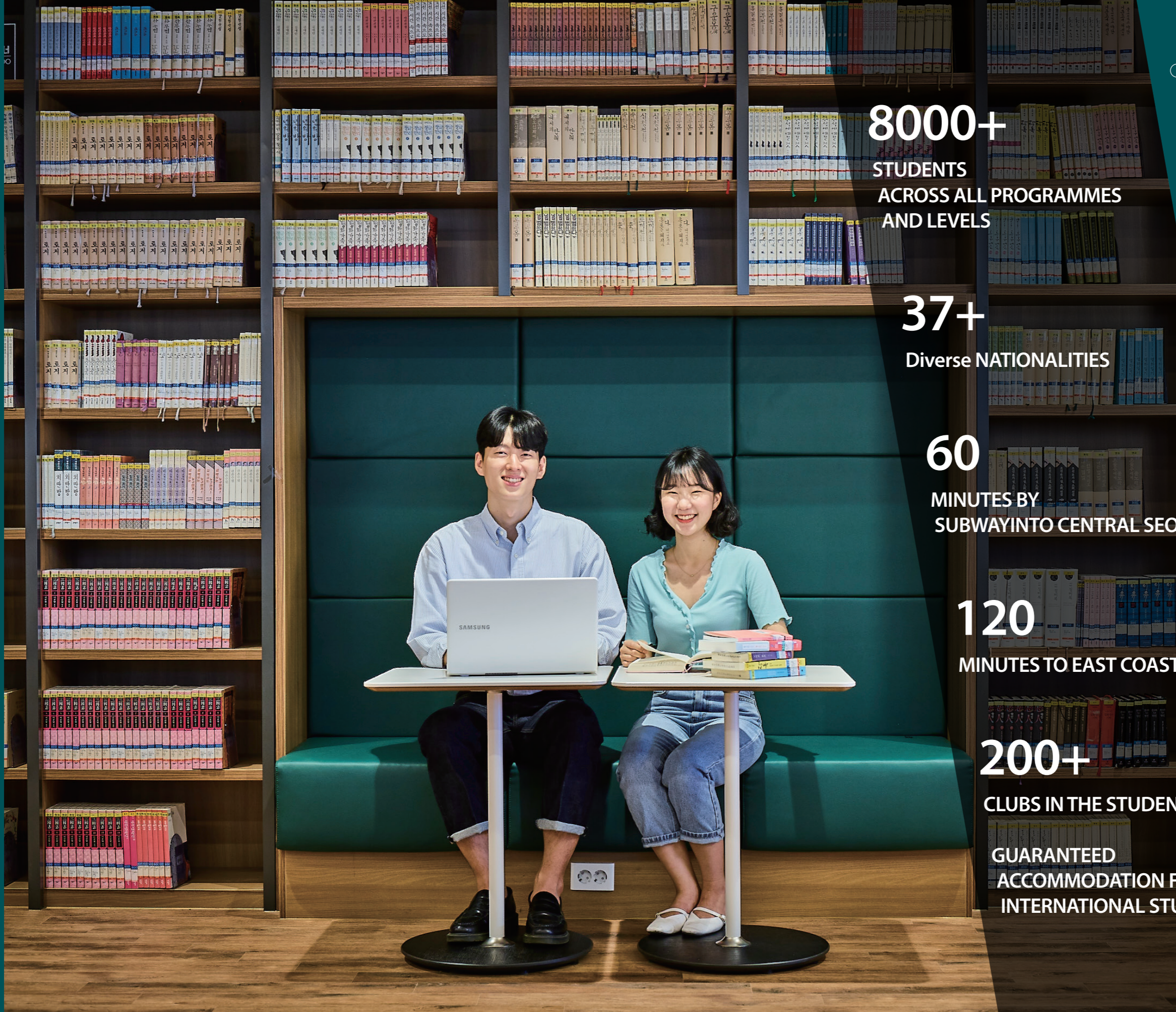

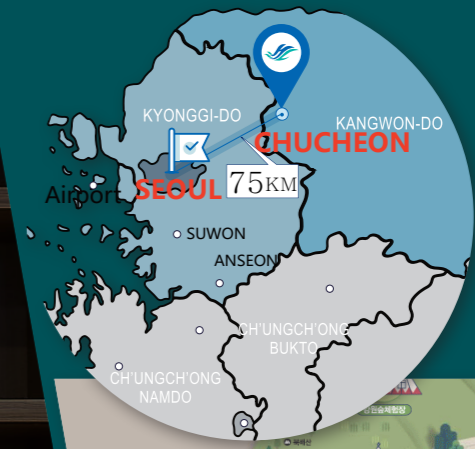
